- -Ensures technical systems are functional, safe, and meet event needs.
- -Coordinates several sets of volunteers, which may include field attendants, scorekeepers, score runners, and Emcee.

**Prerequisite:** Basic knowledge of the competition games, rules, and table set-up. Previous *FIRST* LEGO League Challenge experience. Training required.

**Days/Hours:** Tuesday – Saturday, full day. Pre-event participation required.

Number of Volunteers in Role: 1 Minimum Age Requirement: 21

## \*Volunteer Minimum Age Requirement

**15 years old**—the minimum age requirement for a *FIRST* volunteer at *FIRST* Championship. No age exceptions are permitted for the championship event. Individuals under the age of 15 will not be accepted as walk-on volunteers at *FIRST* Championship.

A minor must have a parent or guardian give written permission to volunteer and minors must work in pairs as assigned by *FIRST* in accordance with the *FIRST* Youth Protection Program policy.

\*\* Volunteer needs, such as hours or number of volunteers per role, may change leading up to the current year Championship event.
