

Reviewing Tips

Thank you for being a reviewer!

Reviewers play a crucial role in creating a positive, inspiring experience for *FIRST*[®] LEGO[®] League Explore teams. This program is designed for young children (ages 6–10) who are just beginning their STEM journeys.

The Reviewer Role

- Recognize every team Give positive feedback on what the team accomplished, learned, and shared.
- Create a supportive space Ask open-ended questions and use a gentle tone to support a lowpressure conversation.
- Model Gracious Professionalism® Be kind, respectful, and inclusive in your interactions with children, coaches, and fellow reviewers.





Training & Resources

If provided, attend your event's reviewer orientation or training. You should also familiarize yourself with the following documents:

- Season Overview Summary of FIRST LEGO League Explore and the season theme.
- Reviewing Sheet List of questions and criteria for the reviewing session, plus the list of awards that teams can win.
- Reviewing Flowchart Order of activities and suggested timing for the reviewing session.

Tips for Interacting with Teams

- Use the Reviewer Sheet questions to guide your conversations or create your own age-appropriate questions to ask the teams about their work.
- Rephrase questions if children don't understand and ask the coach for help if needed.
- Be engaged and encouraging listen actively while teams share, and if you're able, sit or crouch to connect with them at their level.
- Give equal time to each team; use the Reviewing Flowchart for timing.
- Spend more time on areas where the team is eager to share.
- If you finish early, ask if there's anything else they want to show or tell you.

Celebrate! FIRST LEGO League teams are exploring STEM through creativity, curiosity, and teamwork. Praise their progress, learning, and imagination and select the award that best fits what they share.
